### Youth Guidelines

1. One adult chaperone for every five youth ages 12-18.
2. Adult chaperones are encouraged to raise funds for box.
3. Children under 12 years old should be with a parent.
4. Register when arriving at the event.
5. Encourage all participants to ask 20 people to pledge for them to stay overnight.
6. Youth are encouraged to collect donations and secure in a provided envelope.
7. Fees need to be brought sealed to the event.
8. Checks need to be made payable to Family Promise of Lewis Clark Valley with a note in the memo line – “Cardboard Box City”.
9. Plan to get your own boxes – available at Sears, Deranleau’s area Furniture stores (Sylvan’s & Folletts).
10. Awards will be given for most pledges received per group, as well as creative design of cardboard box, etc.
11. No alcoholic beverages or pets allowed.
12. Dinner will be available or bring your own.
13. Enjoy our entertainment – music, games, and much more!
14. Bring bottled water.
15. Please advise all youth to be respectful of others.
16. Commemorative t-shirts will be given out to the first 100 participants (first come, first served).
17. Quiet hours are from 10:00pm – 6:00am. Security will be provided during quiet hours and these times will be enforced for the comforts of all in attendance and the surrounding neighbors.
18. A FREE pancake breakfast will be served from 6:00am – 7:30am.
19. Take down is from 6:00am – 8:00am - all cardboard will be recycled. All non-cardboard items (ie: screws, cloth, metal pieces) should be removed and disposed of in provided trash cans.
